Code of Conduct

Doreinu Inc. is an educational nonprofit that seeks to provide educational content related to Jewish identity and Israel to college age and young professional Jews. Doreinu seeks to run social and educational programming in cities and on campuses across the United States. Local Doreinu leaders, volunteers, and participants are expected to follow the organization's rules and procedures. *The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited at all Doreinu events*. Any participant or staff member who violates this Code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program and from participating in future Doreinu events. Violations must be documented and reported to Doreinu's Managing Director and a sitting board of director.

- Abusive language towards a staff member, volunteer or another participant.
- Possession or use of illegal drugs.
- Possession or use of alcohol by participants that are under the age of 21.
- Bringing dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar items.
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow participant, staff member or volunteer.
- Verbal, physical or sexual harassment of another participant, staff member or volunteer.
- Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- Failure to follow any agency policy or procedure.
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant.

Individuals that are leading/organizing a Doreinu event are required to sign the acknowledgment and enforce the Code.
